

Standard Level MODEL COURSE OF STUDY

The Standard level is comparable to a typical classical school curriculum. It provides a thorough study in all disciplines of classical education and allows considerable flexibility for students just starting. Contact our office for help with planning.

Diploma students seeking a Standard Level diploma are required to take at least **three** online courses per year and maintain at least a **70%** numerical grade (at least a "C"). Must include one English (Composition II or higher), one Language, Senior Thesis, two math (Algebra II and Pre-Calculus), Omnibus (three of the four years), and one science (Biology or higher). Students are required to follow VPSA curriculum. Courses in black in 7th and 8th grade are prerequisites.
